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About SGIA

Sekolah Global Indo-Asia (SGIA) opened in 1998 to serve the educational needs of children from national and international communities living in and around Batam. It is a co-educational day school, enrolling students from Pre-K (age 2) to Grade 12.

Accreditation

SGIA is the authorised Cambridge Assessment International Education School and the only International Baccalaureate World School in Kepulauan Riau. English is the medium of instruction at the school.

Student Body & Graduates

In the 2023-2024 Academic Year, SGIA Secondary School Department enrolls 351 students comprising 14 different nationalities. We are proud that 100% of our 2023 Academic Year cohort has acquired acceptance from universities across the globe.

Faculty

The secondary school has 51 faculty members and academic staff. They are diverse and come from different parts of the world. Most have International Baccalaureate, Cambridge Assessment International Education, or National curriculum certification. The teachers and students ratio is 1 to 8.

Grading System & Academic Transcript

SGIA does not provide GPA to students' transcript. Records of semester report cards are utilised for official school transcript which reflect the CAIE & IB grading system.

Academic Year & Calendar

Our academic school year starts in July and ends in June, where the students attend six 60-minute classes per school day. The academic year is divided into two semesters; July to December and January to June, each semester, is divided into two terms.

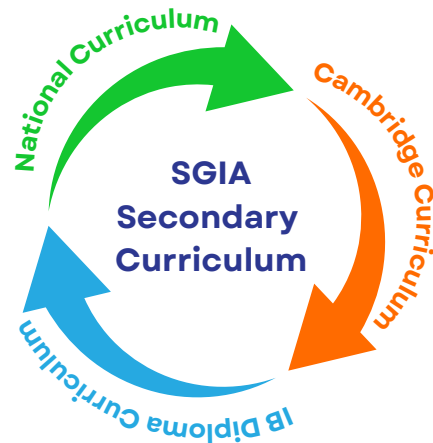

SGIA has been authorised since 2007 to deliver the CAIE (Checkpoint, IGCSE, AS & A Level) and since 2016 to offer the IB Diploma Programme.

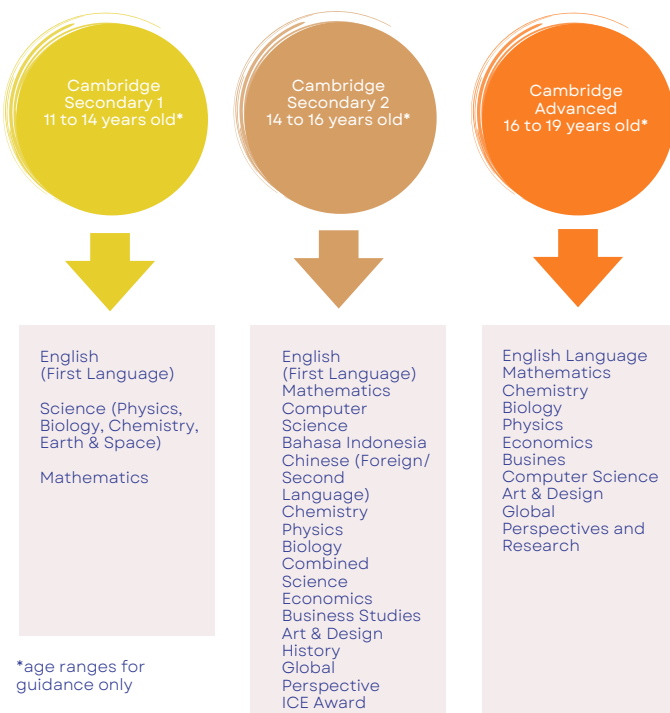

The Cambridge Lower Secondary curriculum is for students from Grades 6 to 8; Cambridge Upper Secondary is for students from Grades 9 and 10 (IGCSE), while the Cambridge Advanced is offered to students at Grades 11 & 12.

Our school policy is for students in Grade 8 to take the Checkpoint examination and for students of Grade 10 to take a minimum of 5 subjects and Grades 11 to 12 to take a minimum of 3 subjects in the external examinations as they see fit with their university plans. We have over 286 students in all levels studying Cambridge Curriculum.

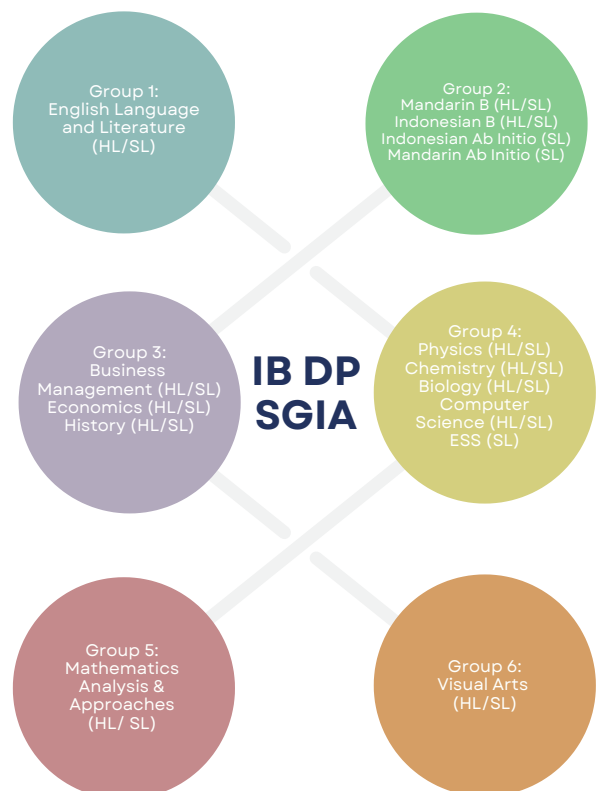

SGIA was authorised to implement the IB Diploma Programme in 2016. The presence of core components; Extended Essay (EE), Theory of Knowledge (TOK), and Creativity Activity & Service (CAS) contributes to our students in meeting the SGIA mission. We have 64 students studying for the IB Diploma and that number is growing each year. In the May 2023 session, our highest score is 41 (1 student) and the school average is 32.1 higher than the DP world average of 30.24
